Hence not comparable
- 5 The above financial results were reviewed by the Audit Committee and approved by the Board of Directors at its Meeting held on November 11, 2020. These results for the quarter and period ended September 30, 2020 have been subjected to a "Limited Review" by the statutory auditors of the Company.
- 6 Fee and commission income majorly includes commission from syndication loan.
- 7 During the quarter ended June 30, 2020, the Parent Company allotted 54,775 equity shares pursuant to the exercise of options under its Employee Stock Option Scheme.

8 COVID-19 virus, a global pandemic has affected the world economy including India. In preparing the accompanying consolidated financial results, the group's management has been required to make judgements, estimates and assumptions that affect the application of policies and reported amounts of assets, liabilities, equity, income and expenses. These estimates and associated assumptions, especially for impairment loss allowance under Ind AS 109 of the financial assets, are based on historical experience and various other factors including the possible effects that may result from the pandemic. These estimates and associated assumptions are believed to be reasonable under the current circumstances. In the event the impacts are more severe than anticipated, this will have a corresponding impact on the carrying value of the financial assets, the financial position and performance of the group and it's operations.

In accordance with the relevant RBI guidelines on 'COVID-19 Regulatory Package' dated March 27, 2020, April 17, 2020, and May 23 2020, the company has granted moratorium of three months on payment of all instalments/interest, as applicable, falling due between March 1, 2020 and August 31, 2020 to all eligible borrowers based on the requests. For all such accounts where the moratorium is granted, the asset classification shall remain stand still during the moratorium period (i.e. the number of days past-due shall exclude the moratorium period for the purposes of determining whether an asset is non-performing). Accordingly, for all such accounts where moratorium has been granted, the number of days past-due shall exclude the moratorium period for the purposes of asset classification under the Income Recognition, Asset Classification and Provisioning norms as well as for staging of those accounts for impairment loss allowance under Ind AS. 4 During the quarter ended September 30, 2020, the Company allotted 54,775 equity shares pursuant to the exercise of options under its Employee Stock Option Scheme.

5 The above financial results were reviewed by the Audit Committee and approved by the Board of Directors at its Meeting held on November 11, 2020. These results for the quarter and period ended September 30, 2020 have been subjected to a "Limited Review" by the statutory auditors of the Company.

6 Hon'ble Supreme Court, in a public interest litigation (Gajendra Sharma vs. Union of India & Anr), vide an interim order dated September 3, 2020, has directed that accounts which were not declared NPA till August 31, 2020 shall not be declared as NPA till further orders. However, such accounts have been classified as stage 3 in accordance with Note No. 8 and provisioned accordingly.

7 The Company has primarily two reportable business segments namely Fund based Activities and Advisory services for the quarter and period ended September 30, 2020. The Company publishes standalone financial results along with the consolidated financial results and in accordance with Ind AS 108 - Operating Segments, the company has disclosed the segment information in the consolidated financial results of the Company

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8 COVID-19 virus, a global pandemic has affected the world economy including India. In preparing the accompanying financial statements, the Company management has been required to make judgements, estimates and assumptions that affect the application of policies and reported amounts of assets, liabilities, equity, income and expenses. These estimates and associated assumptions, especially for impairment loss allowance under Ind AS 109 of the Company's loans, are based on historical experience and various other factors including the possible effects that may result from the pandemic. These estimates and associated assumptions are believed to be reasonable under the current circumstances. In the event the impacts are more severe than anticipated, this will have a corresponding impact on the carrying value of the loans, the financial position and performance of the Company and it's operations.

In accordance with the relevant RBI guidelines on 'COVID-19 Regulatory Package' dated March 27, 2020, April 17, 2020, and May 23 2020, the company has granted moratorium of three months on payment of all instalments/interest, as applicable, falling due between March 1, 2020 and August 31, 2020 to all eligible borrowers based on the requests. For all such accounts where the moratorium is granted, the asset classification shall remain stand still during the moratorium period (i.e. the number of days past-due shall exclude the moratorium period for the purposes of determining whether an asset is non-performing). Accordingly, for all such accounts where moratorium has been granted, the number of days past-due shall exclude the moratorium period for the purposes of asset classification under the Income Recognition, Asset Classification and Provisioning norms as well as for staging of those accounts for impairment loss allowance under Ind AS.
